Day	Location	Description / Activities
1	Phnom Penh <i>(2 days / 1 night)</i>	Upon arrival, Dinh will check your passport, which is required to enter Cambodia. It must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of entry; without this, access to the country may be denied. The journey to Phnom Penh will be by bus, taking approximately 6 hours and offering a first glimpse of Cambodian landscapes.
2	Exploring Phnom Penh	Immerse yourself in Cambodia's poignant history by visiting the Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum (S-21). Then, marvel at the Royal Palace and the Silver Pagoda, true symbols of the capital's splendor. For getting around, hop into a traditional tuk-tuk and explore the city like a local.
3	Siem Reap <i>(4 days / 3 nights)</i>	The trip to Siem Reap will be by bus. Upon arrival, explore a floating fishing village on Tonle Sap Lake, where daily life unfolds on the water. Afterwards, venture into a nearby national park to admire a waterfall and enjoy a walk through lush nature.
4	Angkor Temples	Dedicate a day to discovering the majestic Angkor temples, remnants of the 629-year-old Khmer capital. Nature intertwines with the ancient stones, and each temple tells the fascinating story of the Khmer Empire. Highlights include Angkor Wat and Ta Prohm, where architecture and nature merge into a magical setting.
5	End of the Trip	Your journey comes to an end. Dinh accompanies you to your hotel or directly to the airport. Always attentive to your needs, he remains available to assist you and answer your questions until your departure.
